The initiative petition must meet the following criteria for Board of Trustees consideration:

- 1) The petition has been submitted in compliance with the prerequisites of this policy.
- 2) The petition is consistent with the mission statement and primary positions of the Association.
- 3) The petition does not seek any specific management action(s).
- 4) The petition addresses a previously adopted resolution or addresses a priority, value, opinion, belief, conviction, and/or position which is appropriate and helpful for the education of young adolescents.
- 5) This item shall be placed on the agenda for the next Board meeting occurring thirty (30) days after submission of a valid initiative petition. The Chair will assign a Trustee to communicate the status and/or Board action with respect to the proposed action to the Agent.

The initiative petition form must be signed by 25 individual or institutional members, 12 of whom hold individual memberships. Include a signature sheet with the 25 member signatures when submitting the initiative petition.

The completed initiative petition form must be submitted to the chair, chief executive officer, and the appropriate trustee no less than 30 days prior to the board meeting for placement on the agenda.
